**Derek Hyra** is an associate professor in the School of Public Affairs at American University whose research focuses on processes of neighborhood change, with an emphasis on housing, urban politics, and race. He'll talk about this book, *Race, Class, and Politics in the Cappuccino City* within the context of the new ACM exhibition *A Right to the City*. The book is an ethnographic investigation of the redevelopment of Washington, DC's Shaw/U Street neighborhood. His other books include, *Capital Dilemma: Growth and Inequality in Washington, DC* – co-editor (Routledge 2016) and *The New Urban Renewal: The Economic Transformation of Harlem and Bronzeville* (University of Chicago Press 2008).
